Law 360, New York (January 15, 2014, 8:48 PM ET) — The Federal Trade Commission on Tuesday signed a \$32.5 million settlement with Apple Inc. to resolve claims that the company unfairly billed parents for in-app purchases their kids had made without their permission, an authority-stretching move that will force many companies to rethink their disclosure practices.
